What is WYD?

World Youth day is the largest youth event in the world and will be held in Sydney. Through the WYD 08 experience, young people from throughout the world will make a pilgrimage in faith, meet, and experience the love of God. They will renew their Baptismal calling, rediscover the centrality of the sacraments and discover new apostolic zeal to witness. All in the context of Australia and the hospitality of the Australian people.

Where will I stay?

The WYD office will find accommodation for each registered participant. Accommodation will be simple. Be prepared to bring a sleeping bag and mat.

How much does the pilgrimage cost?

For just **S\$2,250**, airfare, accommodation and food are covered. Payment is to be made in 3 installments:

- \$500 initial (non-refundable) deposit for Registration
- \$1,000 by 30 April 08
- \$ 750 by 31 May 08
